Special Announcement

In view of the increased confirmed and suspected cases of Novel Coronavirus (nCoV) infection, we have undertaken the following measures for the safety of all students and their families, teachers and staff members:

- All students are required to wear a mask, have their temperature checked and spray their hands with alcohol before entering the classroom (Masks are available at \$2 each at our reception desk).
- Students who have travelled to the Mainland must not attend classes for 14 days upon their return.

因應新型冠狀病毒疫情擴散，我們採取了以下措施保障各學生、家長以及教職員的健康：

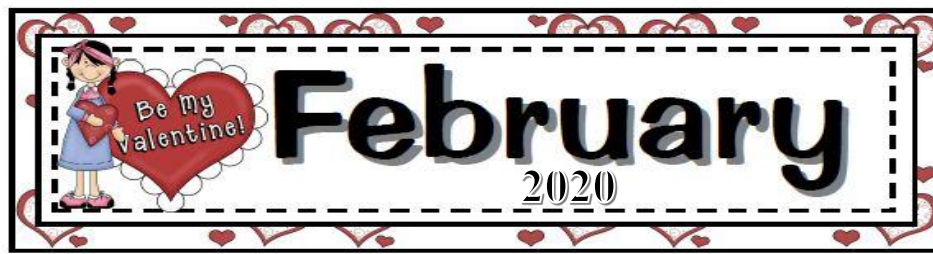

Childhood and Success – By Carmen Cheung Ka Man (WTE6A)

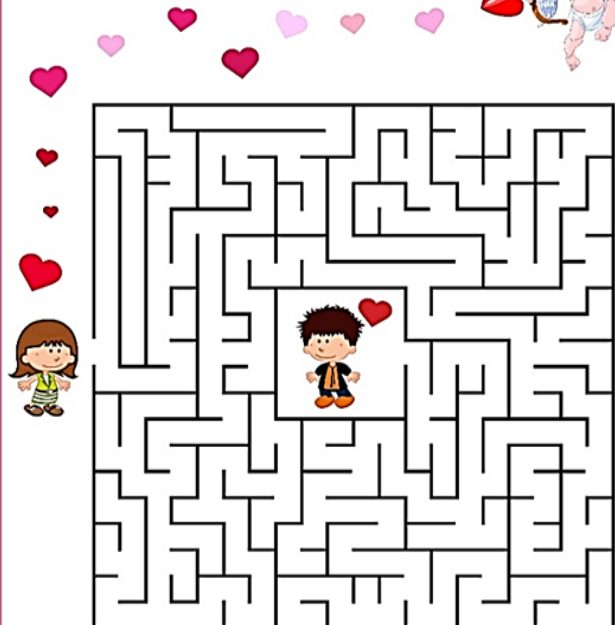
