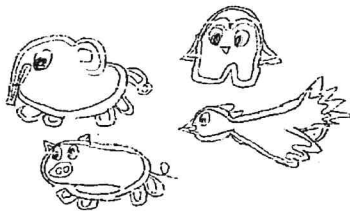
#### Animal Cookies
