Just then, I asked, "What should we do now?" "I think we should call the ambulance!" Sam took out his mobile phone and called, and fortunately someone answered immediately.

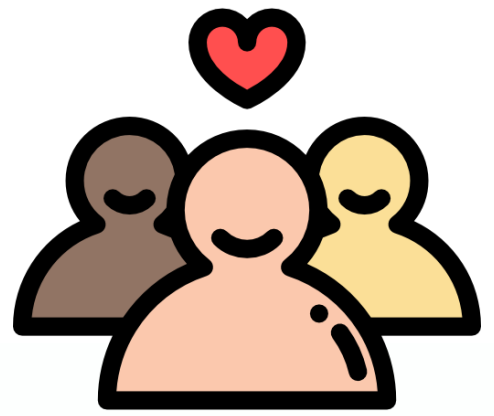

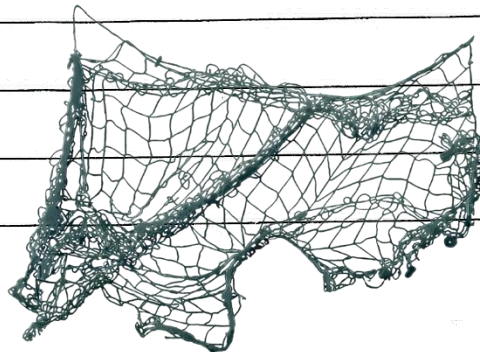
The Lion and the Mouse

The third problem is that the soil is dry and I will use sprinklers to water the soil.

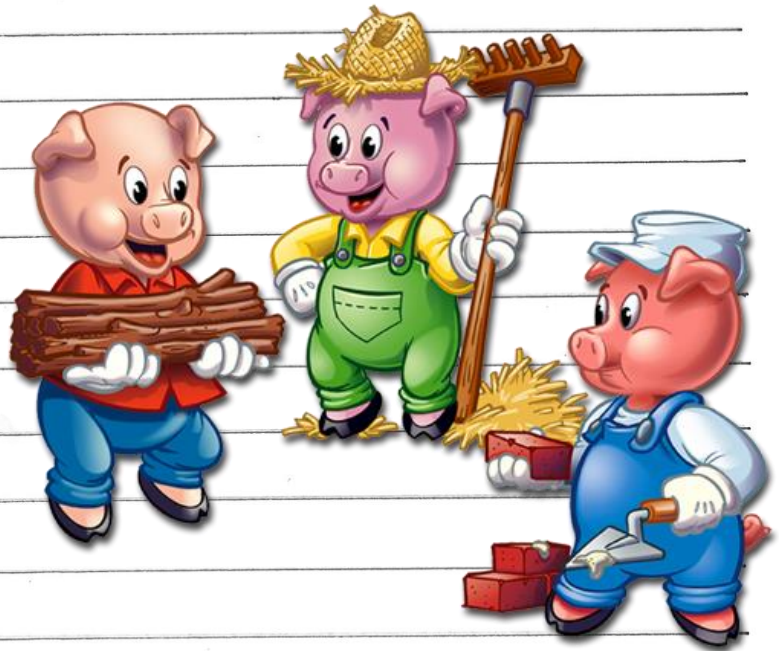
