

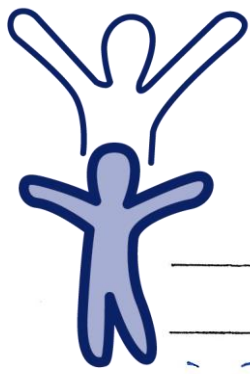

Next day, Oink worked hard, he help the Princess to do everything.

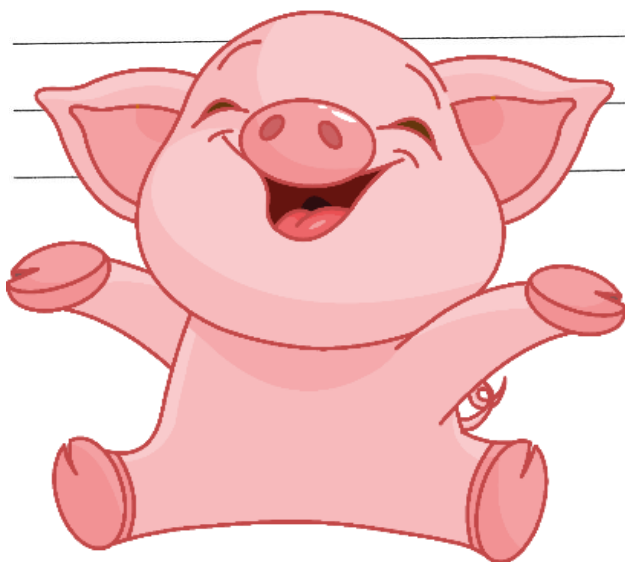
After two years, they had two piglets, two piglets were cute and sensible. The Oink and the Princess like them very much.
